When someone asks, "What do you paint?" I answer, "Dreams and the wind." And trying to make the answer more serious, I add, "Bits of space seen through a grand angle." In fact, this is quite close; with large strokes of my knife and rag, I intertwine branches, thickets and waves – colored hiding places and spaces in which to be lost. Sometimes the canvas is blurred, as if everything fades away, swept far from the gray quotidian.

I work with all the contemporary art performance techniques: live performance where I cast and mold famous or less famous individuals into plaster, sculpture installations, photography in old factories, drawing, painting... Underlining human diversity, I recently organized an important exhibit on the world of left-handed people.

The sculptures exposed here focus on duality, on the multiple facets which constitute men and women and their relation to the outside world. They are witness to my search for a sense of balance as dictated by nature.
